Join us as we put on our annual Springtime on Ice Show. All skaters enrolled in our Learn to Skate USA program and the FFSC are welcomed and encouraged to participate. This is your chance to shine!

Ice Show Dates/Times

Friday May 19th 7:00pm

Saturday May 20th 1:00pm and 7:00pm (2 shows)

All skaters will perform in all shows.

Correspondence

All communication for the show will be done via email. Please be sure to give an updated email address on your ice show application.

Ice Show Applications

Ice show application and initial payment is due no later than January 30th. NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Solos and Features

Solos and features are chosen using the current ice show criteria and points system. To qualify for a solo or feature the skater must be a First Club Member of the FFSC, must have contracted at least 4 hours of FFSC club ice and must have been in the last two consecutive FFSC Springtime on Ice Shows.

Exception: **Staff's Choice Solo**. The FFSC Springtime on Ice staff will collaborate on choosing one skater to obtain this solo. This skater needs to be a current First Club Member of the FFSC and must have purchased 4 hours of FFSC Club Ice. **Regional Soloist**: non-qualifying or qualifying event with top 4 placement, current member of FFSC, skaters must compete in a level with an axel, and have one consecutive year as a FFSC club member.

Soloist will be posted by February 10th in Sprite Arena. The Director will select the theme and music for each soloist. Soloist are responsible to purchase their own costume, ice time, and coaches fees for choreography. Costumes must be approved by the Director, by March 1st.

Features will be posted by February 10th in Sprite Arena. The Director will select the theme and music for each duet, trio, and/or quartet. Ice show costumes will be provided for you. Each feature will be given a coach and set choreography sessions.

Production Numbers: (Senior or Junior production is mandatory for solo and feature skaters)

Club Production- for any first club, second club, or initiation member of the FFSC. There is no tryout for this number.

Junior Production- For skaters 12 and under as of application deadline. If passed Pre-Preliminary Free skate, or participated in Junior production last year, you're exempt from having to try out. All other skaters must tryout. Required elements: loop jump, flip jump, and sit spin (4) revolutions.

Senior Production- For skaters 13 or older as of application deadline. If passed Preliminary free skate or if you participated in Senior Production last year, you're exempt from having to try out. All other skaters must tryout. Required Elements: loop jump, flip jump, and sit spin (4) revolutions.

Freestyle Production- No age limit. Skater must try out every year, unless passed Intermediate Freeskate. Required elements: Axle, camel (4) revolutions, layback spin.

Skills Production- Open to any basic skills or club member who competed in at least 4 competitions in the snow-plow through the no-test level. There is no tryout for this number.

Production Number Tryouts

If your skater is interested in a production number, please check with their private lesson coach to determine if your skater is able to complete the skills required. The tryout fee is \$15 for each production number. Skaters must pay the fee and turn in the attached try out form when attending tryouts.

Tryout date: Monday, January 23rd at 5:30. Please see Mel Chapman.

Group Numbers

All skaters who do not qualify for a solo or feature will be placed in a group number. The groups are split and decided by the ice show committee based on age, level and/or ability. Each group will be provided with 4 choreography sessions, coach, and costumes.

Parent Meeting

We will have a parent informational meeting in which detailed packets will be handed out. Exact schedules of practice and rehearsal times will be included as well as several other important topics. All club ice and ice show fees must be paid in full before a packet will be handed out. The date of the parent meeting will be TBD.

Payments and Fees

The total amount due for the show will be broken down into three equal payments.

January 30th- First Payment and Application Due. NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED

February 27th- Second Payment Due

March 27th- Final Payment Due

Please remember that all club ice dues and ice show fees must be paid in full before participation in the show.

NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.

Ice Show Fee-\$259 Includes ice, professional fees, costume for one group number or feature- *Does not include tights*. Also includes \$48 worth of show tickets. Reminder: solo skater's ice, professional fee and costume is not included. Solo costume fee of \$25 will be credited to show balance as soloist must purchase their own costume.

Club Production Number- \$75 Includes Ice Show T-Shirt, ice, and coaching fees. You must provide black leggings/skating pants

Freestyle Production Number- \$100 Includes costume, ice, and coaching fees.

Senior/Junior Production Number- \$100 Includes costume, ice, and coaching fees.

Skills Production Number- \$100 Includes costume, ice, and coaching fees.

Practice and Rehearsals

All practices generally occur the two weeks prior to the show week. All groups and production numbers will have 4 Choreography sessions. A detailed schedule will be given at the parent meeting.

Show week begins on May 15th. Show rehearsals will be on the 15th, 17th, and 18th.

Volunteers

As always the show could not go on without all our wonderful volunteers. We require that each parent sign up to volunteer for at least one rehearsal and one show. Sign-Up Genius will be used for volunteers.

Props- we are in need of prop builders. If you are interested in helping us put together our backdrop and props for the show, please let our Director, Mel, know.

Fundraising

Please help in participating in all show fundraisers. This will help provide the lights and props for the show. Fundraisers will be announced at a later date.
